

These airy, romantic flowers with sturdy, flexible stems are now loved by florists all over the world.

IT'S AN ART!

The breeding and developing of new varieties is no piece of cake. Especially with a Clematis. Only 0.01% of all seedlings makes it to the final selection. The process takes over a decade, and before any new variety is introduced it has to meet our strict selection requirements, like an excellent vase life (10 to 14 days minimum), strong stems and an exclusive appearance not seen before in the market.

We only want the best, so our clients can surprise their costumers again and again with the Clematis Amazing® series. To do so, we work closely together with our breeder for new varieties, while our dedicated staff provides nurture and care in the field to our established varieties.

A SHORT BIT OF HISTORY

In 2006, Marginpar introduced the Clematis Amazing® Blue Pirouette as the first clematis cut flower at Royal FloraHolland. Clematis Amazing® Inspiration followed in 2011 and Clematis Amazing® Star River was added in 2012. Star River even won the prestigious Glass Tulip Award for best innovation in the cut flower category. In the spring of 2015, Clematis Amazing® London was introduced and in the course of the same year Clematis Amazing® Rome, Clematis Amazing® Oslo and Clematis Amazing® Geneva entered the stage. Clematis Amazing® Miami was introduced in 2017. Clematis Amazing® Tokyo and Clematis Amazing® Kibo followed in 2018. Early 2020 a new addition is added: Clematis Amazing® Havana, followed by a long-awaited white variety end of 2020: Clematis Amazing® Vienna. Our latest introduction, early 2021, is the bicoloured Clematis Amazing® Sevilla.

THE FUTURE

Marginpar is keen on innovation of summer flowers, new varieties are trialed on a regular basis. Future plans for the *Clematis Amazing® family* include more variety in shape and colours (both bold as pastel), bigger flowers and stronger stems.

NOTHING IS AS IT SEEMS

The Clematis has a delicate look, but don't be fooled by her fragile appearance. The Clematis Amazing® series is bred with very sturdy flower petals and a high resistance to botrytis, a fungus that can affect flowers and plants during growth and transport.

THE PERFECT STAGE OF RIPENESS

The Clematis Amazing® series is intentionally harvested with two slightly opened flowers (with the four-flowered varieties). Extensive testing shows that a riper harvested Clematis has a longer vase life. The longer a flower grows on the plant, the more energy it receives. That energy results in bigger and stronger flowers. It is very important to harvest at precisely the right moment. That is why we harvest multiple times a day, to ensure the perfect opening stage.

AVAILABILITY

The Clematis Amazing® series is grown at our flower farms in Kenya, Tanzania and Zimbabwe. Growing flowers close to the equator, in a warm climate, makes them year-round available. We love our Clematis, but she is not an easy flower to grow. The plants require quite a lot of maintenance, some more than others. Plus, some varieties grow fast, while others take their time in the field. To simplify things, we subcategorized the series in Original and Special.

Originals have the best availability and the highest volume and Specials are very niche; available in small volumes and in certain seasons.

CARE TIPS

Clematis is a grateful flower and if you treat her right, she has a vase life of 10 days minimum. In a warm or dark environment, the life span will be shorter, in a cool and light room the flowering stems can last up to 3 weeks. How do you keep Clematis happy?

- Clematis is a heavy drinker. So loves fresh, clean, cold water, and lots of it.
- The thirsty clematis therefore dislikes small water tubes and floral foam.
- Use clean sharp scissors to cut off the bottom part of the stem.
- We recommend Chrysal flowerfood (universal).
- If you remove some of the foliage, the flowers will last even longer.
- Place the vase as light as possible but not in direct sunlight.
- Clematis last best in a cool place. If the vase will be placed in a warm room, put the vase 24 hours in a cool place first.
- And, like all flowers:
 - Don't place flowers near a fruit bowl, the fruit accelerates the aging process.
- Use a clean vase, preferably clean the vase first with bleach or detergent.

HOW MANY FLOWERS?

Some *Clematis Amazing® varieties* have one big flower on top, while others have four or even six flowers per stem. Why is that?

Every Clematis starts out with five or more flowers per stem: one on top and four on the side branches. During the development process we look for the best ratio between stem and flower. Some varieties look better with four flowers, while others look better with a single flower on top. During the growth, we pinch and remove the head bud of the varieties that look their best with four flowers. If the ornamental value is higher with one big flower, we leave all buds. The plant will put all her energy in the top flower, making it larger than the secondary buds.

This process makes the varieties with one flower extra-large, since all the energy is focused on that one bud instead of four. An exception is *the Clematis Amazing® Tokyo*. This special variety is extra powerful and makes six large buds per stem.

FUN FACT

The flowers and flower buds of the cut flower Clematis have the amazing property to turn upright when the branches are used horizontally. It's called geotropism, a response to the stimulus of gravity and influenced by the plant hormone 'auxin'. Hormones promote growth within plants. Plant hormones are unequally distributed throughout the stems and roots, making roots grow down, and stems go up. When the stem grows against the force of gravity it's called 'negative geotropism'.





Blue Pirouette

The one that started it all... Clematis Amazing® Blue Pirouette was the first Clematis cut flower to be traded at the Royal FloraHolland flower auction by Marginpar in 2006. The curved petals of Blue Pirouette give her a cheerful appearance, making her suitable for many different floral styles.

They add a special twist to floral design and gradually unfold.






Migmi








Well this is a weird, fluffy variety, isn't? The Clematis Amazing® Kibo is not grown for its beautiful flowers, but for the seed head! This cuddly specimen is named after Kibo, one of the peaks of Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania. The Clematis Amazing® Kibo grows at the foot of this very same mountain. Kibo is great fresh but is an interesting dried flowe as well. Dried, the fuzziness factor multiplies times 4.




Tokyo

Powerrrrr! Our Tokyo might look sweet and innocent, but she is the strongest variety of all! That is why we grow her with six flowers per stem. She is so powerful; she will open all six, starting from the bottom upwards. An extra amazing quality is that the flowers will turn upright, against gravity, even when used horizontally.

The long vines of the Clematis Amazing® Tokyo are great for special designs: wedding decorations, funeral wreaths, etc. Strong but flexible and excellent to braid, making it a very special flower for those florists that want to stand out from the crowd.
