MARGINPAR **FLOWERS**

Our flowers can be divided into three categories: Originals (year-round available and in large numbers), Seasonals (available in certain seasons) and Specials (surprising 'niche' flowers in small numbers). We consistently create a unique quality of summer flowers. Always stylish and rich in colour.



Originals are available in large numbers all year round. Both beautiful fillers and exclusive flowers, that have been cultivated with attention to detail. How about our Clematis Amazing[®] series, or the Eryngium Questar[®] series, that are loved by florist all over the world? We have 45 different varieties, divided over 14 crops.



Seasonals are summer flowers, available in certain seasons. Because we grow our flowers in Africa, where seasons are different from the Dutch growing season, they surprise the market at times other growers can't. The Jatropha Firecracker, for example, or the Scabiosa Scoop® are seasonals. **We have 16 different varieties, divided over 10 crops.**



Specials are niche flowers, not regularly available and produced in small numbers. These flowers have a very high distinctive character, florist can really distinguish themselves from their competition using our specials. The Gloriosa Rothschildiana, for instance falls into the 'special' category.

We have 17 different varieties, divided over 7 crops.

AMMI VISNAGA CASABLANCA



These elegant, large summer flowers are perfect filler flowers. The large, white umbels stand on sturdy stems. The flowers look a lot like lace and are a sensational addition to any bouquet.

ASTER DARK MILKA



Aster comes from the ancient Greek word astere which means star and refers to the shape of the flower.

ASTER FLASH



The Germanic people believed that the aroma of burnt leaves from dead asters chased away poisonous snakes and evil spirits for the winter. In modern floral language, aster stands for love and patience.

ASTRANTIA BILLION STAR®



The flowers have a very fine structure. The extensive availability and excellent vase life make Astrantia a wonderful product for commercial floristry.

ASTRANTIA STAR OF FIRE®



Actually, only the heart consists of real blooms, a bunch of tiny flowers on thin stems. A kind of Biedermeier bouquet. The wreath of 'petals' around the heart consists of bracts, also known as windings.

ASTRANTIA STAR OF FLAME®



The Dutch common name for the Astrantia is named after a traditional piece of jewelry: 'Zeeuws Knoopje'. They were made of silver or gold and were at the time a status symbol: the larger the button, the richer and more important the wearer was.

ASTRANTIA STAR OF LOVE®



The rootstock and the plant are still used today in folk medicine as a stomachstrengthening agent. Substances in the Astrantia have a beneficial effect on the secretion of gastric juices. It is also used as an appetite stimulant.

ASTRANTIA STAR OF PROMISE®



That is why in English, the Astrantia is called: *Great Masterwort*. The name would be derived from magister: master of healing plants.

CLEMATIS AMAZING® BLUE PIROUETTE



The Blue Pirouette is a unique purple-blue cutting clematis. This Clematis has 4 flowers per stem. Ideal for bouquets because these flowers have a long vase life!

CLEMATIS AMAZING® INSPIRATION



The Clematis Amazing® Inspiration is a particularly beautiful purple-pink cutting clematis. This Clematis has 4 flowers per stem.

DIANTHUS ANTIGUA



Carnations, their real name is Dianthus, were first cultivated by the Greeks. The word 'dios' refers to the god Zeus and the word 'anthos' means 'flower'. A divine flower!

DIANTHUS CARAMEL



Carnations are known for their long vase life and are frequently used in floral designs and bouquets.

DIANTHUS EVEREST



The popularity of the flower goes back a long way; the Romans, for example, already made wreaths and fresh perfume out of the carnation.

DIANTHUS GOBLIN



The carnation is still often added to men's fragrances because it doesn't smell so strong. The carnation is also frequently used for the preparation of potpourri.

ERYNGIUM SIRIUS QUESTAR®



The Eryngium Sirius Questar[®] is a beautiful decorative thistle with a white heart. This belongs to the Questar[®] series and is the only white Eryngium on the market.

ERYNGIUM SUPERNOVA QUESTAR®

GYPSOPHILA XLENCE®

The smooth, shiny berries of the hypericum are clustered on woody stems and come in an array of different colours, like this bright green one.

HYPERICUM MAGICAL PINK GIANT



Cut hypericum start out with bright yellow, star-shaped flowers loved by bees. The berries develop after the blooms fade away.

HYPERICUM MAGICAL TRIUMPH



Hypericum used to be placed above photos in the house during St. John's Day to ward off evil spirits. Hence the general name St. John's wort.

HYPERICUM SAKURA FLAIR®



Almost 2,400 years ago, Hippocrates, the father of medicine, recommended St. John's wort to treat nervous unrest. The black dots along the margin of the blossom contain hypericin, which is believed to act as an antibiotic and antiviral.

HYPERICUM TOMATO FLAIR®



This hypericum from the Flair® series is an ideal addition to any bouquet and has a beautiful bright red colour and round berries.

SOLIDAGO CARZAN GLORY



Solidago, also called *Goldenrod*, is the perfect filler flower. This flower is a strong and voluminous cut flower, making it ideal for use in mixed bouquets. This Solidago has a very good vase life and opens nicely.

LIMONIUM PRINSESS DIAMOND



There are several stories about Limonium leaves: they are said to have a healing effect and to stop flowing blood.

LIMONIUM SAFORA DARK BLUE



The flower petals look a bit like paper. These beautiful branching species with almost misty branches are full of small flowers in yellow, pink or lilac shades.

LIMONIUM SCARLET DIAMOND



Perhaps the name doesn't mean anything to you, but you might recognize the Limonium as a dried flower from the '80s. Nowadays, this summer flower is back and fits perfectly with a vintage way-of-life.

LIMONIUM SENSY WHITE



The name Limonium comes from Leimon (Greek) and means meadow. The plant originally grows mainly near the sea, in a salty meadow in fact. You might also encounter variations of this flower under the name Statice of sea lavender.

MOLUCCELLA LEAVIS



The Moluccella Leavis has long green stems, filled with peculiar green calyxes (the small real flowers are inconspicuously).

ORNITHOGALUM PRINCE STAR™



Ornithogalum is a genus of bulbous plants from the asparagus family (Asparagaceae).
