Our flowers can be divided into three categories: Originals (year-round available and in large numbers), Seasonals (available in certain seasons) and Specials (surprising 'niche' flowers in small numbers). We consistently create a unique quality of summer flowers. Always stylish and rich in colour.



Originals are available in large numbers all year round. Both beautiful fillers and exclusive flowers, that have been cultivated with attention to detail. How about our Clematis Amazing® series, or the Eryngium Questar® series, that are loved by florist all over the world?

We have 45 different varieties, divided over 14 crops.



Seasonals are summer flowers, available in certain seasons. Because we grow our flowers in Africa, where seasons are different from the Dutch growing season, they surprise the market at times other growers can't. The Jatropha Firecracker, for example, or the Scabiosa Scoop® are seasonals.

We have 16 different varieties, divided over 10 crops.



Specials are niche flowers, not regularly available and produced in small numbers. These flowers have a very high distinctive character, florist can really distinguish themselves from their competition using our specials. The Gloriosa Rothschildiana, for instance falls into the 'special' category.

We have 17 different varieties, divided over 7 crops.
