Our flowers can be divided into three categories: **Originals** (year-round available and in large numbers), **Seasonals** (available in certain seasons) and **Specials** (surprising 'niche' flowers in small numbers). We consistently create a unique quality of summer flowers. Always stylish and rich in colour.



Originals are available in large numbers all year round. Both beautiful fillers and exclusive flowers, that have been cultivated with attention to detail. How about our Clematis Amazing® series, or the Eryngium Questar® series, that are loved by florist all over the world?

We have 45 different varieties, divided over 14 crops.








Seasonals are summer flowers, available in certain seasons. Because we grow our flowers in Africa, where seasons are different from the Dutch growing season, they surprise the market at times other growers can't. The Jatropha Firecracker, for example, or the Scabiosa Scoop® are seasonals.







We have 16 different varieties, divided over 10 crops.



Specials are niche flowers, not regularly available and produced in small numbers. These flowers have a very high distinctive character, florist can really distinguish themselves from their competition using our specials. The Gloriosa Rothschildiana, for instance falls into the 'special' category.

We have 17 different varieties, divided over 7 crops.

	Actually, only the heart consists of real blooms, a bunch of tiny flowers on thin stems. A kind of Biedermeier bouquet. The wreath of 'petals' around the heart consists of bracts, also known as windings.

	The Dutch common name for the Astrantia is named after a traditional piece of jewelry: 'Zeeuws Knoopje'. They were made of silver or gold and were at the time a status symbol: the larger the button, the richer and more important the wearer was.

ASTRANTIA STAR OF LOVE®											
	The rootstock and the plant are still used today in folk medicine as a stomach-strengthening agent. Substances in the Astrantia have a beneficial effect on the secretion of gastric juices. It is also used as an appetite stimulant.

ASTRANTIA STAR OF PROMISE®											
	That is why in English, the Astrantia is called: <i>Great Masterwort</i> . The name would be derived from magister: master of healing plants.

HYPERICUM MAGICAL GREEN POWER



The smooth, shiny berries of the hypericum are clustered on woody stems and come in an array of different colours, like this bright green one.

HYPERICUM MAGICAL PINK GIANT



Cut hypericum start out with bright yellow, star-shaped flowers loved by bees. The berries develop after the blooms fade away.

HYPERICUM MAGICAL TRIUMPH



Hypericum used to be placed above photos in the house during St. John's Day to ward off evil spirits. Hence the general name St. John's wort.

HYPERICUM SAKURA FLAIR®



Almost 2,400 years ago, Hippocrates, the father of medicine, recommended St. John's wort to treat nervous unrest. The black dots along the margin of the blossom contain hypericin, which is believed to act as an antibiotic and antiviral.

This orange-red Gloriosa is supplied from Tanzania almost all year round. This characteristic flower comes to full bloom and has a long vase life. The Gloriosa Superba is very exclusive and is used in special flower arrangements.

LIMONIUM CHINA SUMMER



Limonium is an excellent cut flower with a long shelf life. An ideal bouquet filler. This beautiful filling flower is known for its delicate appearance.

LIMONIUM COOL DIAMOND



The fine branch structure and fragile flowers provide an exclusive and playful appearance. The petals are more for the sweet appearance. Limonium is a grateful friend: strong, helpful and sweet.

LIMONIUM PRINSESS DIAMOND

LIMONIUM SAFORA DARK BLUE



The flower petals look a bit like paper. These beautiful branching species with almost misty branches are full of small flowers in yellow, pink or lilac shades.

LIMONIUM SCARLET DIAMOND



Perhaps the name doesn't mean anything to you, but you might recognize the Limonium as a dried flower from the '80s. Nowadays, this summer flower is back and fits perfectly with a vintage way-of-life.

LIMONIUM SENSY WHITE



The name Limonium comes from Leimon (Greek) and means meadow. The plant originally grows mainly near the sea, in a salty meadow in fact. You might also encounter variations of this flower under the name Statice of sea lavender.

ORNITHOGALUM PRINCE STAR™



Ornithogalum is a genus of bulbous plants from the asparagus family (*Asparagaceae*).

POLIANTHES PINK SAPPHIRE



Polianthes Pink Sapphire grows in elongated stems producing clusters of scented waxy white flowers. Because of its sweet smell, extracts are often used in perfumery. Pink Sapphire distinguishes itself by a beautiful soft tone color.
